# Cherry Blossoms Tour

### Visit: Tokyo/ Lake Yamanaka/ Takayama/ Kanazawa/ Kyoto/ Hiroshima/ Osaka

Day 01: Mon 29 March 2021 - Australia/Tokyo Depart Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane or Perth on your overnight flight to Tokyo.

#### Day 02: Tue 30 March 2021 - Tokyo

Upon arrival into Tokyo, you will be met and transferred to Hotel Grand Nikko Tokyo Daiba for two nights. Tonight, dine on a traditional Japanese Welcome Dinner. (D)

#### Day 03: Wed 31 March 2021 - Tokyo

Spend a day appreciating the harmonious blend of 'old and new' Tokyo. Firstly, visit the Imperial Palace Double Bridge, home to a traditional Japanese garden, tea pavilion, stone walls and a moat. Then visit Asakusa Kannon (Sensoji) Temple, one of Japan's most important Buddhist sites, and continue to Nakamise shopping street. Return to the hotel for free time. (B)

#### Day 04: Thu 1 Apr 2021 - Tokyo/Lake Yamanaka

This morning visit the Edo Tokyo Museum which showcases the history of Tokyo during the Edo Period. Then head to Ganko Ginza 1-Chome where you will get to experience sushi making and then enjoy some sushi for lunch. After lunch, visit the famous Ginza Shopping district. Transfer by coach to Lake Yamanaka (approximately a 2-hour journey) and check-in at Hotel Mt. Fuji for two nights. (B/L/D)

#### Day 05: Fri 2 Apr 2021-

#### Lake Yamanaka/Mt Fuji/Lake Yamanaka

Travel by coach to Mt Fuji, Japan's most famous peak. Ride the aerial ropeway at Mt Kachi Yama and enjoy the grand views of Mt Fuji and Lake Kawaguchi. Then visit the Oshino Hakkai springs, a recognised UNESCO World Heritage Site. (B/D)

#### Day 06: Sat 3 Apr 2021-Lake Yamanaka/Takayama

#### (Please prepare an overnight bag as your suitcase will be delivered by courier to Hotel Nikko Kanazawa the following day.)

This morning transfer by coach to Odawara Station for the Bullet Train (Hikari) ride to Nagoya Station. Then travel by Limited Express Train (Hida) to Takayama Station. On arrival in Takayama, enjoy a half-day walking tour which will include Takayama Jinya. Then take a walk down the famous Sannomachi Street in Takayama's old town and see traditional homes, merchant houses, sake breweries, shops and cafes. Enjoy dinner at a restaurant (Hida Beef set meal). After dinner, you will be transferred to the Best Western Hotel Takayama for one night. (B/D)

#### Day 07: Sun 4 Apr 2021 -Takayama/Kanazawa

Travel by coach to Gokayama in a mountainous region, declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site and famous for its traditional gassho-zukuri farmhouses. Visit a Gokayama Japanese Paper Village then transfer by coach to Kanazawa (1hr) to visit Omicho Market, a covered food market since 1721. After lunch you will visit a Sakuda Gold & Silver Craft centre and Nomura Samurai House which is a historic home and garden in Nagamachi. Then visit Kenrokuen Garden, one of Japan's "three most beautiful landscape gardens. Final stop will be at Higashi Chaya District, where you will see old teahouses with latticed windows. Spend one night at Hotel Nikko Kanazawa. (B)

#### Day 08: Mon 5 April 2021 - Kanazawa/Kyoto

(Please prepare an overnight bag as your suitcase will be couriered to Hotel Granvia Kyoto the following day.) Drive to Kanazawa Station and ride the Bullet Train to Kyoto followed by a half day tour. After lunch, visit Kinkakuji where you will find the two top floors covered in gold leaves. You will then be transferred to Hotel Granvia Kyoto for three nights. (B/L)

#### Day 09: Tue 6 April 2021 - Kyoto

This morning visit Fushimi Inari Shrine, famous for its torii gates and trails through the forest of Mount Inari. Then head to Sanjusangendo Temple. After lunch, enjoy a traditional tea ceremony and then stroll around Gion, Kyoto's famous Geisha district. This evening, enjoy a traditional Kaiseki dinner while watching a performance by a Maiko, an apprentice Geisha. After dinner, you will be transferred back to the hotel. (B/D)

#### Day 10: Wed 7 April 2021 - Kyoto

Travel by coach to Arashiyama. With Mt. Arashiyama as the backdrop, take a walk through the Sagano Bamboo Grove. Visit the temple gardens of Tenryuji, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of Kyoto's best Zen temples. Then head to Togetsu-kyo Bridge and enjoy the scenery. It is also the perfect spot for viewing the spring cherry blossoms. Return to the hotel for some free time in the afternoon. (B)

#### Day 11: Thu 8 April 2021 - Kyoto/Hiroshima

(Please prepare an overnight bag for 2 days as your suitcase will be couriered to Hotel Granvia Osaka on Thursday.) This morning you will be transferred to Kyoto Station for the Bullet Train to Hiroshima Station. On arrival, you will be transferred to Hotel Granvia Hiroshima for two nights. The afternoon is at your leisure. (B)

#### Day 12: Fri 9 Apr 2021 -Hiroshima/Miyajima/Hiroshima

Drive to Miyajimaguchi Station to take a ferry to Miyajima to visit Itsukushima Shrine with its watery torii gate. Then wonder through the Hiroshima Peace Memorial Museum & Park, established in 1949 after the Pacific War ended. The museum was built to remind future generations of the terror wrought by atomic bombs. Then visit the preserved Atomic Bomb Dome. (B/D)

#### Day 13: Sat 10 April 2021 -Hiroshima/Kurashiki/Kobe/Osaka

Travel by coach to Kurashiki and visit the Kirashiki Bikan Historical Quarter. Transfer to Kurashiki Station to take the train to Okayama and then travel by Bullet Train to Shin Kobe to visit the Hakutsuru Sake Brewery Museum. Travel by coach to Osaka and spend two nights at Hotel Granvia Osaka. (B)

#### Day 14: Sun 11 April 2021 - Osaka

This morning visit Osaka Castle, then head to the Floating Garden Observatory on the 39th floor of the Umeda Sky Building breathtaking views of the city. The rest of the afternoon is at leisure. This evening, enjoy a Farewell Dinner at a local restaurant. (B/D)

Day 15: Mon 12 April 2021 - Depart Osaka Your wonderful tour comes to an end today as you transfer to the airport for your overnight flight home. (B)
