





ravel Club consultants have been working diligently on Club Wyndham South Pacific owners' behalf to negotiate with airlines, rail companies, accommodation and touring suppliers. Hold times to these suppliers have increased markedly, with some involving a four to six-hour wait. This has put added pressure on the team. Policy changes for airlines and suppliers are also a daily occurrence.

Travel Club consultants make these calls to suppliers from mobile phones so as to not tie up the inbound call lines.

Since the onset of the pandemic, the team has worked long hours as a result of the extended hold times and difficulty in unravelling and cancelling bookings. Your consultants are quite often still working late into the night to fix impacted bookings or logging on to their PCs on the weekend to follow up with clients.

The Travel Club team have been meeting via online video calls every day to discuss the policies, authority waivers and best solutions to the ongoing situation.

These meetings have helped to keep the team positive during one of the most challenging times the industry has ever faced. The teamwork and drive amongst the team has been extraordinary and continues to be, as we battle the latest lockdowns and the havoc this causes on travel bookings.

Behind the scenes, we have been negotiating contracts with new Associate Resorts to provide you with more domestic travel options while the border restrictions prevail.





FILL YOUR FRAME. The camera sees everything. Fill your frame with the subject by moving closer or zooming in and removing any unnecessary visual clutter.



USE FILL FLASH IN THE

DAYTIME. A secret for flattering photos of people in daylight/outdoors is using your camera flash function. It is referred to as fill flash and it will fill up any unflattering shadows.



USE A TRIPOD. Tripods enable you to use long exposure shots and low light conditions - and let you star in your own photos! Mini tripods are inexpensive and can fit in a handbag or backpack.



EDIT YOUR PHOTOS. Whether you have a high-end camera or just your mobile phone, use an editing app such as Adobe Lightroom, from the App Store or Google Play.

→ When the island we now call Tasmania was mapped by the Dutch explorer, Abel Tasman in 1642 he named it "Anthoonij van Diemensland" after the governor of the Dutch East Indies, but later, it was renamed Van Diemen's land by the British.

Now it is an Australian state with some of the most beautiful and interesting historical cities and national parks in the world. Many sites share a history which can be traced back to some very dark days.

Between 1788 and 1853. some 25.000 women were transported to Australia for their crimes and 50 percent of those were sent to Van Diemen's Land. Men, women and children

and children convicts were sent all the way from England in sailing vessels. Some were sent for the smallest of crimes, such as pickpocketing and put in gaols such as the historic Richmond Gaol, (which was built five years prior to the historic Port Arthur Gaol) or the huge Female Factory in Hobart, famous for its use of female convicts to make clothes and mend linen.

With so much to visit and see in Hobart and its surrounds, our stay was remarkably busy, and that included a drive up to Mt Wellington, a Hobart Historic Cruise, Mawson's Hut Museum, using the Red Decker Hop-On Hop-Off bus tour, a visit to Richmond and Port Arthur.


The highlight was a fabulous full-day bus and ferry trip down to Bruny Island, with Bruny Island Safaris.

Our tour leader / bus driver, Nigel who picked us up at 5.30am from our resort in the morning and dropped us off at 6pm, gave us, and all the guests the most knowledgeable, humorous, and entertaining drive and stop-offs.

Our tour included a beautiful morning tea, which Nigel set up and included wood fired oven bread, Bruny Island Cheese, and the best huge Tasmanian shucked oysters I have ever tasted.

We also stopped at the Bruny Island Cheese Co. and Bruny Island Honey before Adventure Bay Lookout, where the view from the top of the stairs overlooking the narrow neck was astounding.

The next stop-offs were Bruny Island Chocolate and Fudge, Bruny Island Berry Farm, and a farm just past Adventure Bay where we saw a large white wallaby grazing among the usual brown wallabies.



Lunch at the Hotel Bruny was outstanding (along with their Bruny Island Cider) before going on to Lunawanna and the last stop - Cape Bruny Island Lighthouse – and oh boy, what an amazing and historic climb to the very top of the old lighthouse, with all its past history and technical information shown and explained to us by the keeper.

So, do not worry about the cooler weather in Tasmania: it's still one of the most beautiful and friendly places to visit in the world.







The pool decking has been made larger and additional pool loungers added along with side tables.


The rooftop garden has also been enhanced; a fresh lick of paint has refreshed the outer walls and new pool signage installed.





