
Hiking Victoria's Second-Highest Mountain



COOK YOUR OWN FEAST

Be inspired by one of Australia's most renowned chefs

Growing up, the kitchen was always Peter Kuruvita's favourite place. The heady mix of fragrant spices, the warmth of smoke and steam, and the happy music of chatter and laughter were the ingredients that inspired his creativity and ignited his passion.

To Peter, cooking brings back that simple joy he experienced in his ancestral home in Colombo, Sri Lanka, with his grandmother and aunts – and has become the way he shares that joy with others. These memories have helped shape his stellar career as one of Australia's leading chefs. Peter Kuruvita launched into the spotlight by starting the Flying Fish Restaurant & Bar in Sydney, which he led as Executive Chef for eight years, and he opened Flying Fish Fiji in Fiji during 2008. In 2013, he opened Noosa Beach House, then followed that with Alba Noosa in 2021. His glittering career gathered further star power with three books – Serendip: My Sri Lankan Kitchen, My Feast with Peter Kuruvita, and Lands of the Curry Leaf. He's also repeatedly appeared on the small screen through Island Feast with Peter Kuruvita, Mexican Fiesta with Peter Kuruvita, Peter Kuruvita's Coastal Kitchen, and My Sri Lanka with Peter Kuruvita. Peter recently held four live cooking demonstrations for guests at Club Wyndham Phillip Island and Club Wyndham Dunsborough. More than 100 guests had the privilege of cooking along with the master chef, creating popcorn prawn skewers and kottu roti, a popular street food in Sri Lanka.

Peter's partnership with us served to highlight the mouth-watering tastes of South Pacific and Sri Lankan cooking, enrich the experience of club owners and guests, and demonstrate the ability families have to create their own feasts and memories using their apartment-style club accommodation, particularly at these two club favourites.

Peter's appearance ignited inspiration for many Club Wyndham South Pacific owners, who took to either their home kitchens or their holiday kitchens (in selfcontained club apartments) to add flavour to their social feeds with their gourmet creations and make memories of their own with their families.

JAPAN'S CHARM

The Hakone Open Air Museum, with its worldrenowned sculptures, was a feast for the eyes and soul.

Next, we stayed at **Club Wyndham Sundance Resort Karuizawa** in a cosy apartment

Karuizawa in a cosy apartment with single beds, a living area, a basic kitchen, and a good bathroom. The resort manager also tried his best to communicate with us through a language translation app. He is such a fantastic man! We explored Ginza Street, which has many interesting arts and crafts and delectable foods. We visited more temples and shrines and saw a 400-yearold cherry tree in full bloom. Shosha were magnificent, and Nara's ancient temples and famous deer park were also enjoyable. Uji's famous green tea plantations and temples also offered us a serene retreat.

We also had a great time in Kyoto with its ancient temples, the charming Gion district, and Tokugawa's palace (Nijo-jo Castle) - it was my favourite, because of its history.

Fresh look for MARCOOLA BEACH


A breath of fresh summer air has swept into Club Wyndham Marcoola Beach, with all 24 club apartments undergoing a Hamptonsthemed transformation.



Club Wyndham South Pacific's inventory in Sundance Resort Club is structured in a different way to the inventory to the left. The club owns 137,875 points within Sundance Resort Club, which enables owners to access all Sundance Resort Club's 16 resorts and apartments. The rest of the Sundance Resort Club points are owned by that club's members and other vacation clubs managed by Travel + Leisure Co. This arrangement means Club Wyndham South Pacific owners can access a broader range of inventory – all 19 Sundance Resort Club rooms – for a lesser financial commitment to the club than if the inventory was purchased directly. The club does not own the rooms. Bookings at some resorts need to be made through Owner Services. These rooms are tabulated separately to display the unique arrangement and to consider the Japanese apartments are not traditional one, two or threebedroom formats, but are large rooms with multiple beds. Some apartments offer raised Western-style bedding, while others offer futon-style bedding that is customary in Japan.
